Public Notice for the Disposal of Obsolete Textbooks and Instructional Materials

The Board of Trustees of the Salinas City Elementary School District declared on Sept. 20, 2022, that the science curriculum used in the District from 2006-2021 and identified as “California Science” from Macmillan/McGraw-Hill is now obsolete. The Board has approved donation and/or disposal of these materials.

Per state Educational Code 60510.5, this Public Notice will be posted on the District’s website, placed on the District Office entry doors and published four times over a period of 60 days in the Monterey County Weekly, an adjudicated paper of general circulation.

At the end of the 60-day period, Nov. 20, 2022, District and school staff may make these materials available to students, parents/guardians and community members. The date, time and location of the release of these obsolete materials will be made public in advance.

After being made available to the aforementioned parties, the District will move to sell any remaining material of value to the company that offers the highest price, and to dispose of material with no dollar value through donation to a charity or disposal.
